**Chapters from six of the Proceedings of ICNIRS conferences are now freely available, with more to follow.**

The Proceedings of the International Council for Near Infrared Spectroscopy (ICNIRS) conferences are a valuable record of NIR research and development dating back to 1987. There are many gems hidden within them that are easily overlooked by researchers, and the Proceedings are of particular use to newcomers to NIR spectroscopy. Now, IMP Open has made individual chapters from the five Proceedings they have published freely available: 1995, 1999, 2001, 2003 and 2017. In addition, with the kind permission of the organisers, 2011 is also available and 2009 will be soon: more than 1,000 chapters in total.
